The Lee County Grand Jury convened today and has issued indictments in two cases. Anibal Soto Mayor was indicted on two charges, including First Degree Murder for the murder of Dean Blietz on July 2nd. He was also indicted on one count of Robbery with a Deadly Weapon.

The Lee County Grand Jury also indicted Baron Darnell Young on five charges, including First Degree Murder for the murder of Tamara Jo Hyatt on May 31st. He was also indicted on one count each of; Robbery with a Deadly Weapon, Sexual Battery with a Deadly Weapon or Great Force, Grand Theft of a Motor Vehicle and Grand Theft.

Both defendants will now be arraigned on these new charges on Monday, August 18th. Both are being held in the Lee County Jail with no bond. A copy of the indictments is attached.
